Meteorologist's View

Freezing levels listed in the table are too low (will be nearer to 2000 metres) but feeling chilly under cloud cover. High UV levels expected so be prepared for sunburn.

Forecast for Saturday 05 Jun 2021

Weather: Remaining dry and fine with plenty of sunshine, some patchy low cloud possible across far western fells in the evening.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 15 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Little in the way of cloud expected on summits. Small chance of some patchy cloud around 800 metres later in the day across far western fells.

Visibility: Very good

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8 rising to 19 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 9 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
