Forecast for Wednesday 06 Dec 2023

Weather: Dry, clear and very cold with fog patches forming in the glens overnight. The day will be dry, bright and very cold with high cloud spreading northeast from the morning. Cloud will lower in the southwest from late evening bringing light snow. Cloud and snow spread northeast turning heavier later. Southeast winds strengthen from the evening, reaching gale force across the summits later.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 90%

Low cloud and visibility: The visibility will remain good in mostly cloud free skies through the day. Cloud 600-800m will increase from the evening bringing increasing snow and lowering the visibility to very poor.

Forecast for Thursday 07 Dec 2023

Weather: Cloudy and very windy with snow at first, drier for a time around midday. Further outbreaks of rain spread northeast from late afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southeast 45-50mph gust 65mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% increasing 50% for a time around midday.

Low cloud and visibility: Broken cloud 400-600m through the morning will drop to lower slopes in rain from the late afternoon. The visibility will be very poor in early snow and in cloud, poor in rain otherwise good.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 8 Celsius rising plus 3 Celsius

At 800m: Plus 1 Celsius

Freezing level: 700m in the morning, rising 1100m by the evening.
