Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0600 UTC to 0600 UTC

General Situation

A cold northerly airflow will ease through Tuesday as a ridge edges in from the Atlantic. A milder southwesterly airflow will follow across much of the United Kingdom through Wednesday and into Thursday with gales in the north.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest backing southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 for a time.

Wintry showers then rain.

Moderate or good.

Rough or very rough, but mainly moderate in Moray Firth.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8 veering west or northwest 5 or 6.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Rough or very rough, but mainly moderate in Moray Firth, becoming high in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west, decreasing 3 or 4.

Showers at first.

Mainly good.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 or 4 backing westerly 5 or 6.

Fair.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight for a time.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Northerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in southwest, becoming variable 3.

Showers at first.

Southwesterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7.
Occasional rain.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing southwest 5 to 7
later.
Showers at first, rain later.

Southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

gale 8.
Showers then rain.
