Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain with the continued risk of flooding in the northeast, and feeling cold in the strong wind. Elsewhere, a mixture of sunny spells and frequent showers, locally heavy in the southwest. Further heavy rain in the northeast tonight, with snow over the hills. Elsewhere, clear spells and occasional showers.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Persistent, locally heavy rain will continue to affect the northeast on Tuesday, with snow over the hills. Elsewhere, sunny spells and frequent showers, locally heavy with hail and thunder possible. Drier on Wednesday, and colder in the northeast. However, wet and windy weather will spread in from the southwest overnight.
