Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 03 June to 1200 UTC Tuesday 04 June 2019

General Situation

A large low to the north of Scotland will dominate today, and another low will cross from the southwest on Tuesday bringing strong winds at times and some rain or thundery showers in many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough.
Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming north 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rain.

Moderate or rough.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near Rattray Head.
Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, for a time, then veering southwest later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair at first, then thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Thundery rain or showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southeasterly 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Mainly fair at first, then thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west or northwest, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic, 3 to 5.

Moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 3 or less, then north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic and decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in North Channel, becoming mainly slight later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming northerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering north 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in northwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering north 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times in south and far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, but mainly rough in far north and at times in far south.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near Cape Wrath, veering north 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in south.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 03 Jun 2019 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 04 Jun 2019 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will pass to the west of Shetland over the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:

Southwesterly gale force 8 expected soon (issued 2144 UTC on Sunday 2 June 2019)

Southerly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first in northwest, veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8

Moderate or rough

Rain or showers

Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first

Mainly rough

Showers

Moderate or good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards, becoming mainly south to southeast 2 to 4 this evening, locally 5 tomorrow morning.

Slight in the north, smooth in the south.

Isolated showers, then rain arriving in west of area by mid-morning tomorrow, spreading eastwards with a risk of thunder.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor in any heavy rain tomorrow.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 5, veering west to southwest 4 to 5 in the afternoon, perhaps briefly 6 in the west of the area, becoming west to northwest 2 to 4 by Wednesday morning.

Slight, locally smooth in the south, perhaps locally moderate in the northwest, with a low swell.

Showery rain, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing by Tuesday evening risk of isolated showers from midnight.

Good, occasionally moderate or perhaps locally poor at first.

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
