General Situation

Areas of low pressure over and around the United Kingdom will bring rather unsettled conditions to the United Kingdom during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Mainly easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in northwest for a time.
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain.

Variable mainly northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5 later, occasionally 6 in west.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.

Thundery showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southwest later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.

Mainly fair, showers later.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then west or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing southwest, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, showers later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, veering southwest later, 4 or 5, .

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, mainly fair later.

Variable becoming south or southwest, backing southeast later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near headlands.

Slight becoming moderate in north.

Mainly easterly or southeasterly, becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near headlands.

Smooth or slight.

Variable becoming south or southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Easterly or northeasterly, veering southerly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.
Slight or moderate.

Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming east or northeast 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 05 Jun 2011 at 1200 UTC until Monday 06 Jun 2011 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure covers Shetland waters, but this will decline through Monday as low pressure develops in the Norwegian Sea.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Variable 3 or less.

Moderate at first in northwest, otherwise slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jun until 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 4 or 5.

Slight.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 4 to 5, backing northwest overnight.

Mainly moderate.

Scattered thundery showers clearing in the morning.

Moderate to good, locally poor, becoming good in the morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 to 4, locally 5 at first, backing west to southwest on Tuesday.

Slight to moderate.

Risk of a shower on Tuesday.

Mainly good.
