#### General Situation

High pressure centred across the north of the United Kingdom will slowly move away southeastwards during today and Sunday, allowing Atlantic fronts to move into northern and western parts.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable at times in Moray Firth, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Rattray Head.

Occasional rain later.

General Situation

An anticyclone over Shetland will move southeast into the North Sea on Saturday, while a frontal trough tracks east across Shetland later Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3, becoming southeasterly 3 or 4 later in southwest.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north and east.
