Forecast for Tuesday 04 Apr 2023

Weather: Perhaps a few clear spells through the early hours. Otherwise a mostly cloudy but dry day until a band of rain, with associated low cloud, arrives from the west by late evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 80%, reducing to 20% by late evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Good for most of the day. Low cloud, bases 500-700m, gradually pushing in from the west late evening. Temporary reductions in visibility to moderate in any heavier rain.

Meteorologist's View

Feeling cold at height in the strong winds.

Forecast for Wednesday 05 Apr 2023

Weather: Low cloud lingering across the region during the morning with outbreaks of rain, heavy at times. This mostly clearing by midday to leave a drier and brighter period, however further rain arriving from the southwest into the evening.

Maximum wind: Southerly 15-20 mph, gusting 30 mph, easing into the afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 10% during the morning, increasing to 80% into the afternoon, decreasing again by evening to 30-40%.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud, base 500-700m, in association with the rain, with moderate visibility in heavy outbreaks. Good into the afternoon. Further low cloud, 600-800m, and reduced visibility into the evening.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 7 rising to plus 11 Celsius.
 At 700m: Plus 4 rising to plus 7 Celsius.
 Freezing level: Above summits.
