Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today showers across southwest England and south Wales initially, some thundery, then extending across western Wales, before dying away. Further scattered thunderstorms will develop across northern and western England, Wales, Scotland and perhaps Northern Ireland. Becoming generally hot or very hot, away from cooling sea-breezes.

Overnight most of the thunderstorms will die away, leaving clear spells and patchy fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday: Scattered showers and sunny spells. Cloudier and cooler along northeast England and eastern Scottish coasts. Generally hot, locally very hot in the southeast.

Tuesday: Isolated thunderstorms in north and west. Most places dry, hot or very hot, with sunny spells.
