for the period 0600 UTC Thursday 02 June to 0600 UTC Friday 03 June 2011

General Situation

An area of high pressure is expected to cover much of the United Kingdom during the period, with only the far north being affected by Atlantic fronts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing mainly 3 or 4 except in far north.

Moderate or rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

In far north at first, southwesterly 5 or 6 veering northwesterly 3 or 4, elsewhere, variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Smooth or slight, but moderate north and west of Orkney.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight, becoming moderate except in far north.

Fog patches in far north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in far north.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly northerly or northeasterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Smooth or slight.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Poor or very poor becoming moderate later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3.

Slight or smooth.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming north 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate later.

Fog patches.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Southwest 4 or 5 in north at first, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north at first.

Fog patches.

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.

Fog patches at first.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.
Occasional drizzle at first, fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4.
Slight in shelter, otherwise mainly moderate.
Fog patches, occasional rain or drizzle later.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7, decreasing 3 or 4,
occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, but 4 or 5 in north at first, veering
northwesterly later.
Mainly slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or poor, becoming good in north.

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7, decreasing 3 or 4,
occasionally 5 later.
Rough, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, but 4 or 5 in north at first, veering
northwesterly later.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or poor, becoming good in north.
