Forecast for Thursday 04 Jan 2024

Weather: A bright start to the day with hazy sunshine, a few scraps of low cloud over the higher hills. Becoming increasing cloudy into the afternoon although tops generally well above the highest ground. Some light rain is possible in the afternoon in the east of the region, with the best of conditions further west and north.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 80% some patchy cloud around the summits at times, 40% in the east by the afternoon

Low cloud and visibility: Some patchy cloud above 300m first thing, clearing into the morning with cloud bases generally well above the hills. Cloud lowering to 600m in the afternoon for eastern parts of the area. Very good visibility away from low cloud. Poor in slight rain in the east.

Forecast for Friday 05 Jan 2024

Weather: Cloudy with some sunny spells at times, a few isolated showers through the day, which may be heavy at times, with the potential for showers to be sleety on the higher tops.

Maximum wind: Northwesterly 15-20mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 40%.

Low cloud and visibility: Away from showers, cloud bases well above the hill, in showers cloud bases above 600-700m. Visibility good or very good away from showers, poor in showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 2 rising to 6 Celsius.
 At 600m: Zero.
 Freezing level: Around 7-800m
