Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain will continue clearing eastwards today, lingering across northern and north-eastern Scotland. Otherwise, there'll be sunshine and showers, locally heavy with hill snow and thunder possible. Overnight, north-eastern and south-western parts will see some rain but otherwise it'll be dry with some patches of frost or fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Cloud and rain in northeastern parts will ease and clear tomorrow. Southwestern parts will see strong winds with gales in places tomorrow and patchy rain continuing. Winds will ease into Monday and rain will move northwards. Elsewhere, there'll be sunny spells and showers and overnight, the north will see a frost.
